Waverly	Let's see if we can make it easier
Sunshine	Doe, a deer, a female deer, Ray, a drop of golden sun
Beth	Me, a name I call myself, Far, a long, long way to run
Denise	Sew, a needle pulling thread, La, a note to follow Sew
Sugarbabes	Tea, a drink with jam and bread, That will bring us back to Do (oh-oh-oh) Get wild with the beginning word (Doe, Ray, Me, Far, Sew, La, Tea Doe, a deer, a female deer, Ray, a drop of golden sun Me, a name I call myself, Far, a long, long way to run Sew, a needle pulling thread, La, a note to follow Sew Tea, a drink with jam and bread, That will bring us back to Do Do-re-mi-fa-so-la-ti-do so-do!
Waverly	Now do-re-mi-fa-so and so on are the tools we use to build a song. Once you have these notes in your heads, you can sing a million different tunes by mixing them up. Like this.
Sunshine	So Do La Fa Mi Do Re
Beth and Denise	(Echo) So Do La Fa Mi Do Re
Sunshine	So Do La Ti Do Re Do
Beth and Denise	(Echo) So Do La Ti Do Re Do
Waverly	Now, Put it all together and put in words -- One word for every note. Like this.
Sugarbabes	When you know the notes to sing You can sing most anything
Waverly to audience	Let's all sing together starting with "Doe, a deer"
Singalong With audience	Doe, a deer, a female dee, Ray, a drop of golden sun
	Me, a name I call myself, Far, a long, long way to run
	Sew, a needle pulling thread, La, a note to follow Sew
	Tea, a drink with jam and bread, That will bring us back to Do Do Re Mi Fa So La Ti Do, So Do
